General Guidelines

The purpose behind our dress code is to promote school unity and minimize distraction. In addition, the dress code, through its restrictions, is intended to promote self-expression through the development of individual personality rather than expression through outward appearances.

Students must wear a formal school uniform on Wednesdays, for special assemblies, on Picture Day, and on field trips (unless specified otherwise by the administration or teacher). Students are encouraged to wear their House t-shirts and CCA logo wear on Fridays.

We recognize that it is the responsibility of parents to train their children to respect authority and the rules of our school community. We ask parents to see that their children are dressed according to the Dress Code Policy of Calvary Christian Academy. Together, we hope to eliminate the need for teachers to spend valuable learning time reminding students of the Dress Code Policy.

General Uniform Guidelines

- All shirts must be fully tucked in for boys and girls.
- Girls' skirt length must be at or below the knee.
- Girls' hairstyles must be feminine, no shorter than chin length.
- Boys must be clean shaven, with hair out of the eyes and above the collar.
- Boys must wear a belt.
- Jackets/sweaters may not be worn inside out.
- Jackets and hoods cannot be worn in the classroom
- No tattoos.
- No hair coloring or dye (with the exception of girl's highlights that appear natural).
- Small earrings in the ear only.
- No gauge or body piercings.
- Clothing may not have tears, rips, holes, loose threads, or unfinished seams.
- Clothing should be neat and fit well. Sweaters and clothing layers should follow the approved styles. Sweaters should not be bulky, oversized, dress-length, or drape over the entire uniform.

- Uniforms are available for purchase at two recommended school uniform vendors – Educational Outfitters and Lands’ End..
 - An alternate vendor may be used if the item is comparable to the approved uniform design.
 - Select uniform pieces (plaid skirts and striped ties) are only available at these vendors.

School Uniform Rationale

The development of our uniform policy is driven by a desire to create and promote an environment of learning where dress is not a distraction to the educational process. The motivation for the policy has grown out of the following principles:

1. Our goal is to honor God in all we do, acknowledging the Lordship of Jesus Christ in our choices.
2. All human actions, including outward manifestations such as clothing, reveal and communicate the disposition of the heart at some level. It is our desire to address these heart issues in one uniform policy rather than seeking to anticipate and curb the numerous manifestations of it that surface throughout the year with a looser dress code.
3. Clothing represents the vocational calling of a person, and inherent in the uniform policy is a desire to create an environment where undue attention is not drawn to specific students. The neat appearance created by a uniform enhances a ready-to-learn atmosphere.
4. Uniforms help engender a cohesive presentation of the students in our school. When our students are dressed in uniform it communicates, aesthetically, that they are part of the same team, working toward the same goals. The student is part of a group identity that strives for excellence, and the code establishes a tradition toward that end.
5. The uniform code should save parents money. The uniform code de-emphasizes the social impact of dress and helps focus the students on character and academic issues.
6. The uniform code addresses security. On field trips, students in uniform aid the teachers in keeping track of everyone. On the school campus, teachers and staff can clearly identify students from outsiders.

Students are expected to be in uniform while on campus during school hours, unless specified otherwise by the administration. The administration is responsible for the interpretation of the policy, and the enforcement of the policy is the responsibility of parents, administration, and staff.

Bike Shorts	Black bike shorts must be worn under the skirt.
Socks (short or knee high)	White or Black (solid)
Tights	Black (solid)
Sweaters	Black, Navy, Gray, or White (crewneck, v-neck, vest, cardigan, or zip-front sweaters in approved styles.

Accessories	Light Blue, Navy, White, Yellow/Gold (solid); silver or gold jewelry
Jackets	Navy, Black, or Gray (solid or with official CCA logo only)
Socks	White or Black (solid)
Shoes	Shoe base colors: solid white, navy, brown, and black No backless sandals. Solid black or brown boots, heels less than two inches.

Twill Walking Shorts	Khaki or Navy (no cargo shorts)

Belt	Brown or Black
Socks	White or Black (solid)
Sweaters	Black, Navy, Gray (crewneck, v-neck, vest, cardigan in approved styles).
Jackets	Black, Navy, or Gray (solid or with official CCA logo)
Shoes	Shoe base colors: solid white, navy, brown, and black Tennis shoes allowed. No sandals or backless shoes.

Blazer	Navy (long sleeves or three-quarter sleeve)
Button Up Shirt	White (Short or Long-sleeved)
Skirt	“Classic Navy Plaid” Pleated skirt (at or below the knee) <i>Purchase approved style at Educational Outfitters or Lands’ End</i>
Bike Shorts	Bike shorts must be worn under the skirt.
Tights (optional)	Black (solid)
Shoes	Black or Brown Dress Shoes; flats or heels of 2” or less
Jackets	A blazer must be worn all day. No sweaters may be worn over or under the blazer. A heavy winter coat in navy, black, or gray may be worn over the blazer when outside.
Accessories	Light Blue, Navy, White, Yellow/Gold (solid); gold or silver jewelry

Formal Uniform

Blazer	Navy
Button Up Shirt	White (Short or Long-sleeved) A white undershirt may be worn.
Dress Pants	Khaki (no cargo pants)
Tie/Bowtie	Navy/Gold Stripe
Belt	Brown or Black
Socks	Black or Brown (solid)
Shoes	Black or Brown Dress Shoes (No tennis shoes)
Jackets	A blazer must be worn all day. No sweaters may be worn over or under the blazer. A heavy winter coat in navy, black, or gray may be worn over the blazer when outside.

Casual Dress / Jeans Day*

**Standard uniform choices are also appropriate on Fridays*

Shirt	House, CCA, Calvary, CCA retreat T-shirt, or solid colored T-shirt only. Polo or oxford in any color or pattern.
Shorts	Uniform length chino shorts in any color. Jean shorts or cargos are not permitted.
Pants	Uniform pants or jeans are allowed. Sweatpants are not permitted.
Dresses (for Ladies)	Dress of any color. Straps must be at least two-inches wide. The length must be at or below the knee.
Skirts (for Ladies)	Skirt in any color. The length must be at or below the knee.
Sweaters	Knit sweaters and cardigans in any color are allowed. V neck sweaters must have a crew neck shirt underneath.
Sweatshirts	CCA, Calvary, or retreat sweatshirts (with or without a hood) are allowed. Solid colored, crew neck sweatshirts are allowed.
Jackets	CCA jean jackets or CCA sports jackets. Hooded coats cannot be worn inside school classrooms.
Accessories / Shoes	See general uniform guidelines. Sneakers are allowed.

P.E. Dress Code

CCA Shirt	CCA T-Shirt or CCA Athletic Shirt
Shorts	CCA Athletic Shorts or basketball style shorts which are no more than 2 inches above the knee (solid Black, Navy, or Gray)
Bike Shorts	Bike/Compression shorts must be worn under the shorts.
Loose Capris (Girls)	Black, Navy, or Gray (no leggings)
Sweat/Track Pants	Black, Navy, or Gray (no leggings)
Socks	White, Black, or Navy (solid)
Sweaters	Navy, Black, Gray or White (solid, no hoodies/logos/slogans/patches)
Accessories	Light Blue, Navy, White, Yellow/Gold (solid)

Dress Code — General Information

Dress Code Enforcement

Students are required to adhere to the uniform dress code, as described above. For those who are in violation of the dress code, the following procedure will be followed:

- *Improper uniform: for example, shirt, skirt, pants, no belt/tie, skirt length, color, or standard uniform on a Wednesday, etc.*
 - On the first instance, students will be given a conduct notice. Upon the second occasion of a violation, the student will be removed from class and allowed to return after he/she is in compliance with the dress code. In this case, parents may need to return to school with the correct uniform item.
- *Improper sweaters, jackets, or other removable uniform accessories:*
 - The sweatshirt or accessory must be removed prior to continued class participation, and the student will be given a conduct notice.

Dress code violations are entered into the student's FACTS record. In every case, the student may be held out of class until the dress policy is followed, and the student may be marked absent if he or she is out of class for more than 30 minutes. Further disciplinary action will follow the guidelines outlined in the Parent/Student handbook.
