Short-Sleeved or Long-Sleeved White Oxford Shirt



Optional: Non-hooded Sweater, Cardigan, or Sweatshirt (Solid forest green, navy blue, white)



Optional: Outerwear/Jacket (Solid black, navy blue, white) No external logo May not be worn in class



White Plaid A-Line Skirt Below the Knee or White Plaid Jumper. Skirt or jumper must be at knee-length or below.



Black/navy blue bike shorts, leggings or tights *must be* worn underneath a skirt or dress.



Socks: Solid black, navy blue or white *No logo*



Shoes: Solid black, including any logo. Sole can be black, white, gray. Must have closed toes and backs



Heels are allowed for grade 6th-8th only.

Must be block style, no more than 2" high



No tread boots, platforms, rollers or lights. Shoes must be no taller than ankle-

height.

Optional: Outerwear/Jacket (Solid black, navy blue, white) No external logo May not be worn in class











Dress, jumper, skirt, skort, shorts, pants: Navy blue or khaki Dress, jumper, skirt, skort and shorts *must be knee-length or below the knee*. Leggings are only allowed under a skirt or a dress. Jegging (ponte or stretchy knit) style pants are not permitted.





Black or navy blue bike shorts, leggings or tights must be worn under a skirt or a dress.



Solid Black, navy blue or white No logo





Shoes: Single-colored, must have closed toes and backs.



Heels are allowed for grade 6th-8th only. Must be block style, no more than 2" high



No tread boots, platforms, rollers or lights.

Shoes must be no taller than ankle-height.

Purpose and Responsibility

The purpose behind our dress code is to promote school unity and minimize distraction. In addition, the dress code, through its restrictions, is intended to promote self-expression through the development of individual personality rather than expression through outward appearances.

Students must wear a formal school uniform on Wednesdays, for special assemblies, on Picture Day and on field trips (unless specified otherwise by the administration or teacher).

We recognize that it is the responsibility of parents to train their children to respect authority and the rules of our school community. We ask parents to see that their children are dressed according to the Dress Code Policy of Calvary Christian Academy. Together, we hope to eliminate the need for teachers to spend valuable learning time reminding students of the Dress Code Policy.

Dress Code Enforcement

In the case of a dress code violation, teachers in the Grammar and Logic Schools will notify parents of dress code infractions via a white slip and an email.

After repeated violations, the student may be removed from class and allowed to return after he/she is in compliance with the dress code. In this case, parents will be contacted and may need to return to school with the correct uniform item.

Dress Code

The dress code at CCA establishes a particular protocol within our school community. The CCA administration has chosen specific requirements to maintain standards within our school. Students and parents are responsible for meeting these requirements.

The dress code is designed with the following goals in mind:

- To encourage a biblical attitude of modesty and humility.
- To maintain student behavior and productivity.
- To instill in students a sense of loyalty to the school.
- To promote a positive impression of our school within the larger community.
- To make expectations as clear as possible in order to minimize the appearance of arbitrary enforcement.

In the case of a dress code violation, teachers in the Grammar and Logic Schools will notify parents of dress code infractions via a white slip and an email. Teachers in the Rhetoric School will notify parents via a conduct notice and an email. Parents may be asked to bring a change of clothes for the student.

1. General Guidelines

- Clothing must be standard uniform styles.
- All clothing must be properly fit and modest.
- Pants must be worn at or near the waist.
- No holes, tears, frays, patches, or writing are permitted on dress code items.
- Denim may be worn on casual dress days only.
- Shirts must be tucked in throughout the day but may be untucked during recess.
- All but the top button of Oxford shirts are to be buttoned.
- Undergarments should not be visible except in the case of undershirts at the neckline. Undershirts must be white, including the neck band, and should not extend beyond the outer garment's hem or sleeve.
- Skirts and shorts should be at or below the knee (GS and LS). In the Rhetoric School, skirts must be below the knee.
- A dress code shirt must be worn underneath sweaters and jackets.

2. Standard Uniform

Girls in the Grammar and Logic Schools:

- Polo shirt- navy blue, forest green, or white
- Sweater- plain navy blue, forest green, or white (optional)
 - Sweater includes knit or fleece sweaters, cardigans, and sweatshirts

- Hooded sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts are not permitted
- Outerwear/Jacket- navy blue, black, or white may be worn (solid, no external logos/ slogans/or patches). Outerwear may not be worn in the classroom
- CCA-issued sports jacket can be worn on middle school game days or casual dress day
- Dress, jumper, skirt, skort-"white plaid" (Lands' End), navy blue, or khaki
 - Navy blue or black bike shorts must be worn underneath a dress, jumper and skirt
 - Dresses, jumpers, skirts, skorts must be at knee length.
- Pants or shorts
 - Navy blue or khaki
 - Shorts must be knee length
 - Jegging (ponte or stretchy knit) style pants are not permitted
- Socks- navy blue, black or white
- Shoes:
 - Shoes must be school-appropriate
 - Students may wear single colored tennis shoes or simple leather/leather-like shoes
 - Shoes must be ankle-length or below
 - Shoes must not have treads, lights, rollers, or many different colors
 - Shoes must have closed toes and backs.
 - Block-style heels are permitted in grades 6-8 but must be no higher than 2 inches.
 Platforms are not permitted.

Boys in the Grammar and Logic schools:

- Polo shirt- navy blue, forest green, or white
- Sweater- plain navy blue or forest green
 - Sweater includes knit or fleece sweaters, cardigans, and sweatshirts
 - Hooded sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts are not permitted
- Outerwear/Jacket- black or navy blue jackets may be worn (solid, no external logos/ slogans/or patches). Outerwear may not be worn in the classroom
- CCA-issued sports jacket can be worn on middle school game days or casual dress day
- Pants or shorts
 - Navy blue or khaki
 - Pants must not be of stretchy materials
- Belt- brown or black belt (required for Logic School students)
- Socks- navy blue, black, or white
- Shoes:
 - Shoes must be school-appropriate
 - Students may wear single colored tennis shoes or simple leather/leather-like shoes
 - Shoes must be ankle-length or below
 - Shoes must not have treads, lights, rollers, or many different colors
 - Shoes must have closed toes and backs
 - Block-style heels are permitted in grades 6-8 but must be no higher than 2 inches. Platforms are not permitted

3. Formal Dress Attire

Each Wednesday, students are required to wear more formal attire. This formal attire may also apply to additional days, such as field trips and special events.

Girls in the Grammar and Logic School:

- Oxford dress shirt or blouse- white
- Sweater- plain navy blue, forest green, or white (optional)
 - Sweater includes knit or fleece sweaters, cardigans, and sweatshirts
 - Hooded sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts are not permitted
- Outerwear/Jacket- navy blue, black, or white may be worn (solid, no external logos/ slogans/or patches). Outerwear may not be worn in the classroom
- Dress, jumper, skirt- "white plaid" (Lands' End)
 - Dress: White Plaid A-Line Skirt Below The Knee (Land's End)
 - Jumper: White Plaid Jumper Top of Knee (Land's End)
 - Navy blue or black bike shorts must be worn underneath
- Socks- black, navy blue or white
- Shoes
 - Shoes must be school-appropriate
 - Tennis shoes or dress shoes may be worn.
 - Shoes must be solid black, including any logo. Sole can be black, white, or gray.
 - Shoes must be ankle-length or below
 - Heels for dress shoes are allowed for grades 6-12 only
 - Heels for dress shoes must be block-style; less than 2", no thin heels are allowed
 - Shoes must not have treads, lights, rollers, or many different colors. Platforms are not permitted
 - Shoes must have closed toes and backs

Boys in the Grammar and Logic School:

- Oxford dress shirt- white
- Tie-"white plaid" (Lands' End)
- Sweater- navy blue or forest green (optional)
 - Sweater includes knit or fleece sweaters, cardigans, and sweatshirts
 - Hooded sweaters, cardigans and sweatshirts are not permitted
- Outerwear/Jacket- black or navy blue jackets may be worn (solid, no external logos/ slogans/or patches). Outerwear may not be worn in the classroom
- Dress pants- navy blue
- Belt- brown or black belt (required for Logic School students only)
- Socks- black, navy blue or white
- Shoes
 - Shoes must be school-appropriate
 - Tennis shoes or dress shoes may be worn.

- Shoes must be solid black, including any logo. Sole can be black, white, or gray.
- Shoes must be ankle-length or below
- Shoes must not have treads, lights, rollers, or many different colors. Platforms are not permitted
- Shoes must have closed toes and backs

4. Casual Dress Day Attire

Casual dress allows students to dress in non school uniform clothing that is appropriate for school. Students may not look sloppy or unprofessional; students must still adhere to the general guidelines listed in 6.1

Grammar and Logic School:

On days that the school administration or the classroom teacher has designated as a casual dress day, students may wear non-uniform clothes that meet the following requirements:

- Solid or patterned tops with no external logos, graphics, or inappropriate phrases. CCA or Calvary Christian Fellowship-issued clothings are permitted.
- Shirts, sweaters, or sweatshirts must be non-hooded. Exception: Logic School students may wear Calvary Christian Fellowship-issued hoodies (example: CCF camp hoodies).
- For those who have chosen to wear an eligible hooded sweatshirt, hoods must remain off in the classroom..
- Boys: uniform length shorts or pants
- Girls: shorts, pants, skorts, skirts, or dresses. Length must be knee-length or below. Bike shorts must be worn under skirts or dresses.
- Leggings can only be worn under a skirt or a dress.
- Sweatpants, joggers and pajamas are not permitted.
- In general, students must present a clean, modest, and neat appearance, appropriate for the school day. Therefore, extreme style, tight clothing, low-cut tops, bare midriffs, mini dresses, tears or holes are considered unsuitable attire for school.

5. Field Trip Shirts

On field trips, students will wear one of these options per instruction of their classroom teacher:

- Chapel uniform/formal attire
- Field trip shirts (provided by the school) with casual dress otherwise.

6. **Grooming**

- Hats may not be worn
- Girls may wear hair-bows, clips, and headbands in school colors only.

- Students may have naturally colored hair in one shade and natural highlights. Hair must be neatly groomed, and kept out of the eyes.
- Hairstyles:
 - Hairstyles should not be extreme and should not detract in any way from the learning environment.
 - Girls' hairstyles must be feminine, no shorter than chin length.
 - Boys must be clean shaven, with hair out of the eyes and above the collar.
- Tattoos are not permitted (temporary, permanent, or pen/ink markings).
- Ladies may wear small, simple earrings that are non-distracting in the ear only. No gauge or body piercings are permitted.
- Nail polish:
 - Grammar School: No nail polish
 - Logic School: Light pink, natural color, subject to Admin approval
 - Rhetoric School: Light pink, natural color. Light/natural color acrylic (press-on) nails are allowed, subject to Admin approval.
