Purpose

The purpose of the CCA dress code is to contribute positively to a professional learning environment by:

- Promoting school unity
- Maintaining a focus on academics
- Developing self expression within individual personalities
- Encouraging respect for self, others, and the school community
- Representing ourselves as a school of excellence and strength

Students must wear clean clothing that fits well and is the appropriate size. Students are to maintain a neat, modest, and well kept appearance at all times.

We recognize that every rule cannot be specified in the Dress Code. It is the responsibility of parents to train their children to respect the rules of our school community and we do expect parents and students to adhere to the CCA Dress Code. We ask parents to see that their children are dressed according to the Dress Code Policy of Calvary Christian Academy. Together, we hope to eliminate the need for teachers to spend valuable learning time reminding students of the Dress Code Policy.

The motivation for the Dress Code policy has been established from the following principles:

- Our goal is to honor God in all we do, acknowledging the Lordship of Jesus Christ in our choices.
 All human actions, including outward manifestations such as clothing, reveal and communicate
 the disposition of the heart at some level. It is our desire to minimize these heart issues in one
 uniform policy.
- Clothing represents the vocational calling of a person, and inherent in the uniform policy is a desire to create an environment where undue attention is not drawn to specific students. The neat appearance created by a uniform enhances a ready-to-learn atmosphere.
- Uniforms help engender a cohesive presentation of the students in our school. When our students are dressed in uniform it communicates, aesthetically, that they are part of the same team, working toward the same goals. The student is part of a group identity that strives for excellence, and the code establishes a tradition toward that end.
- The uniform code should save parents money. The uniform code de-emphasizes the social impact of dress and helps focus the students on character and academic issues.
- The uniform code addresses security. On field trips, students in uniform aid the teachers in keeping track of everyone. On the school campus, teachers and staff can clearly identify students from outsiders.

General Appearance Guidelines

- Girls' hairstyles must be feminine, no shorter than chin length.
- Boys must be clean shaven, with hair out of the eyes and above the collar.
- Tattoos are not permitted (temporary, permanent, or pen/ink markings).
- Students may have naturally colored hair in one shade and natural colored highlights.
- Small, simple earrings in the ear only that are non-distracting. No gauge or body piercings.
- Nail polish:
 - Grammar school (K-5): no nail polish
 - Logic school (6-8): Light pink, natural color, subject to Admin approval.
- All shirts must be fully tucked in for boys and girls.
- Girls' skirt length must be at the knee or longer.
- Jackets/sweaters may not be worn inside out.
- Jackets and hoods cannot be worn in the classroom.
- Clothing may not have tears, rips, holes, loose threads, or unfinished seams.
- Denim may be worn on casual dress days only.
- Clothing should be neat and fit well. Sweaters and clothing layers should follow the approved styles. Sweaters should not be bulky, oversized, dress-length, or drape over the entire uniform.
- Uniforms are available for purchase at Lands' End...
 - An alternate vendor may be used if the item is comparable to the approved uniform design, with the exception of ladies' skirts and men's ties.
- Students must wear a formal school uniform on Wednesdays, for special assemblies, on Picture Day, and on field trips (unless specified otherwise by the administration or teacher).
- Students are expected to be in uniform while on campus during school hours, unless specified otherwise by the administration.
- In general, students must present a clean, modest, and neat appearance,
- appropriate for the school day. Therefore, extreme style, tight clothing, crop or low-cut tops, bare midriffs, mini dresses, tears or holes are considered unsuitable attire for school.
- The administration is responsible for the interpretation of the policy, and the enforcement of the policy is the responsibility of parents, administration, and staff.

Dress Code Enforcement

Students are required to adhere to the uniform dress code, as described above.

In the case of a dress code violation, teachers in the Grammar and Logic Schools will notify parents of dress code infractions via a white slip and an email.

In addition to the white slip, students may be asked to remove improper sweaters, jackets or other removable uniform accessories prior to continued class participation.

After repeated violations, the student may be removed from class and allowed to return after he/she is in compliance with the dress code. In this case, parents will be contacted and may need to return to school with the correct uniform item.

	Casual Dress Day*
Shirt	Solid or patterned tops with no external logos, graphics or inappropriate phrases, CCA or CCSJ t-shirt. Polo or oxford in any color or pattern. Short or long sleeves. Non-hooded.
Shorts	Uniform length shorts.
Pants	Uniform length pants or jeans. Sweatpants or "joggers" are not permitted.
Dresses, skirts, skorts(for girls)	Length must be at the knee or below. Bike shorts must be worn under skirts or dresses.
Leggings(for Ladies)	Leggings can only be worn under a skirt or a dress.
Sweaters	Hoodless, knit sweaters and cardigans in any color are allowed. V-neck sweaters must have a crew neck top underneath.
Sweatshirts and sweatpants	CCA crewneck sweatshirt; hoodless, solid colored or patterned, crew neck sweatshirts with no external logos, graphics or inappropriate phrases are allowed. Middle school students are allowed to wear CCSJ hoodies. Hoods must be down in the classroom
Outerwear/Jackets	CCA jean jackets or CCA sports jackets. Hooded coats cannot be worn inside school classrooms.
Accessories / Shoes	Shoes must be closed toe. Block-style heels are permitted in grades 6-8 but must be no higher than 2 inches. Platforms are not permitted.
